






## **Forward View**

  - Individuals often the best integrator










During this time Social Care
Funding has *decreased* by 10.7%
in cash (31% real)
terms taking demography into
account: £14.9bn to £13.3bn

The money being transferred from the NHS is not enough to mitigate these spending reductions.
